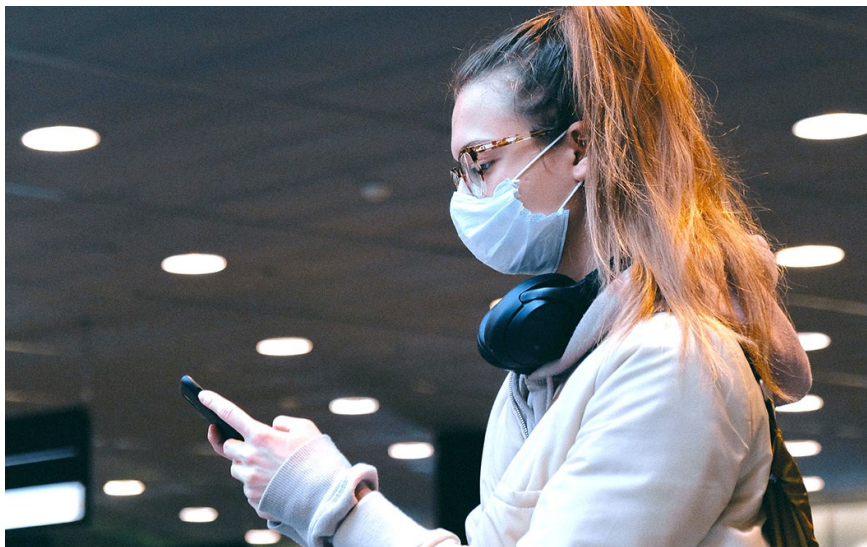

The last guidelines for international arrivals released on 7th January'22 by the Ministry Of Health & Family Welfare, Govt Of India is being revised with new standard operating procedure as released on 20th January'22. The SOP will be valid w.e.f 22nd January 2022 till further notice. Also the list of countries from where travelers need to follow additional measures on arrival in India, including post arrival testing (countries at risk) are as follows:
